Through the **MOScholars Tax Credit Program** and the **Herzog Tomorrow Foundation**, individuals and businesses can turn 50% of their Missouri income tax liability into life-changing scholarships for K-12 students – in exchange for a **100% state tax credit**.

MOScholars Empowerment Scholarship Accounts are awarded to eligible K-12 Missouri students, giving families the freedom to create a customized educational experience that meets their child's unique learning needs. Funds can be used for private school tuition and fees, educational therapies, tutoring, and technology. Scholarships are available for students from working-class families and for those with an IEP (Individualized Education Program).

MOScholars FAQ's

- › **Who is eligible to contribute to this program?**
 - Individuals subject to Missouri state income tax.
 - Businesses subject to Missouri state income tax, including general corporations, subchapter S corporations, LLCs, LLPs, partners, shareholders in partnerships, S-Corps, partnerships, sole proprietorships, and express companies.
- › **What is the tax credit percentage?**
 - The tax credit is equal to 100% of an eligible donation, not to exceed 50% of the donor's state income tax liability.
- › **How do I estimate 50% of my state tax liability?**
 - Individuals may check line 36 of the previous year's Missouri tax return and divide in half.
 - Businesses may estimate using two quarterly tax payments.
- › **What is the deadline to make the contribution for a tax year?**
 - Tax credit reservations and contributions to Herzog Tomorrow Foundation must be completed by December 31st each year to apply to that year's income tax.
- › **What is the carryforward period if the tax credit is not utilized in the application year?**
 - MOScholars tax credits may be carried forward for four (4) subsequent tax years.
- › **Is the tax credit refundable?**
 - The tax credit is not sellable, transferable, or refundable.
- › **What documentation is provided to attach to the Missouri tax return?**
 - After the tax credit reservation and donation is made, the State Treasurer's Office will issue a tax credit receipt.
 - The MO-TC Miscellaneous Tax Credit form must also be included.
- › **Is there an end date to this program?**
 - No. The program was enshrined in state law and does not have a sunset clause or end date.
- › **Can I make my MOScholars donation using a QCD or a DAF?**
 - **QCD:** Yes, you can use a QCD, personal check or online payment for your donation.
 - **DAF:** No, MOScholars donations are not eligible through a DAF. However, you can make a separate outright donation to the Herzog Tomorrow Foundation using your DAF.

MOScholars Tax Credit Reservation Process

Three EASY steps to turn your state income tax into scholarships:

STEP 1

Reserve your tax credit at MOScholars.com, and select **Herzog Tomorrow Foundation** as your EAO.

STEP 2

Herzog Tomorrow Foundation will email instructions on where to make your donation.

STEP 3

The State Treasurer's Office will issue a tax credit receipt to be used when filing your taxes.
